



Skeletal System

Lesson: Skeletal Systems

Materials Needed:

- Cotton Swabs
- Paper (to make Skulls and labels)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Markers (to label skeleton)

Steps:

- Provide materials to students to create their individual projects.
- Students listen and learn about the skeletal system and are shown a visual of a human skeleton labeled with each of the bone types.
- After learning about the human skeletal system, students create their own using cotton swabs and glue—a small dot of glue will do for this project.
- Students either use a marker to label the various bones on their skeleton or pre-printed labels.
